Brundall and surrounding area

The village of Brundall, is perched on the banks of the River Yare - part of the famous Broads. Brundall is surrounded by beautiful, tranquil countryside, but the city of Norwich is only 8 miles away and the Norfolk coast only a 30 minute drive.

Brundall has several village shops, a medical centre, a primary school, a selection of places to eat and a church. Head in to Norwich for excellent shopping, dining experiences and a big dose of history, culture, and a vibrant arts and music scene.

Brundall is the ideal location for anyone who loves watersports such as fishing and sailing, or loves wildlife and bird watching, exploring surrounding countryside and pretty villages. The village has a strong boat making history and the industry is still evident with boat yards and moorings along the river. Time to take up sailing, fishing or kayaking?

The Broads, a National Park, has over 200km of navigable waterways and many Broads (lakes) of all sizes to enjoy. The Broads have 7 rivers, fens, marshes and woodlands making it a vital area for nature.

There is a staggering collection of rare wildlife in the Broads National Park. Despite comprising only 0.1% of the UK, the park area boasts more than a quarter of its rarest wildlife.' *The Broads Authority.*

Norwich is accessible via the A47, which also links to the Northern Distributor Road, A1270, Broadland Northway. There is also a regular train service from Brundall's two train stations to Norwich and Great Yarmouth. Trains run regularly from Norwich to London, Cambridge and the rest of the country. Norwich Airport offers domestic, European and (indirectly) intercontinental flights.

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Energy Efficient Homes

Buying a highly energy efficient home could save you tens of thousands of pounds and help you reduce your carbon footprint.

Are you trying to decide between a new build home and a second hand property? One thing that could sway your decision is comparing the heating costs.

A new Norfolk Homes property could save you thousands of pounds a year when compared to an equivalent size home built to 1980's regulations.

Look at the property's EPC which will provide you with information on the building's energy efficiency and likely running costs for heating, lighting and hot water.


Why are our homes so energy efficient?

We insulate the walls, floors and roofs extremely well - more than is required by current building regulations - fit windows with double glazed, low-E glass, Argon gas filled sealed units and pay close attention to detail in the build process to avoid air leakage and keep warm air where it should be - inside.

To keep you warm and comfortable, we fit luxurious, energy efficient, underfloor heating on the ground floor and thermostatically controlled radiators on others floors. Room temperatures can be controlled individually so you don't waste energy.

We also install energy efficient boilers that supply the underfloor heating, radiators and domestic hot water. A Waste Water Heat Recovery System or Photovoltaic flush fit solar panels make sure heat is not wasted and free electricity for your use is generated.


Directions

From Norwich:

Church Mead is 8 miles from the centre of Norwich. From Norwich, head to the A47 and head in the direction of Great Yarmouth. You will see signs for the Postwick Park and Ride on your left but carry on the A47 until you come to a roundabout. Take the third exit, Cucumber Lane, into Brundall. Take the first left into Berryfields where you will see signposts for Church Mead.

From Great Yarmouth:

Take the A47 towards Acle and Norwich. A roundabout allows you to bypass Acle and to continue on the A47. Brundall is approximately 6 miles from Acle. At the Brundall roundabout you take the second exit, Cucumber Lane, into Brundall. Take the first left into Berryfields where you will see signposts for Church Mead.
